ESTHER RODRIGUEZ BROWN was born and raised in Barcelona, Spain and arrived in the United States in 2001. She started servicing youth in the streets of Las Vegas, using her car as her main office and many times opening the doors of her home for those youth who needed it. In 2007, she began working with incarcerated youths and, in efforts to teach them empathy skills, she founded The Embracing Project. The mission of The Embracing Project is to promote healing for children and youth victims/survivors of sexual exploitation, sex trafficking and violence through the development of specialized programs, trauma-informed care, and unconditional support. Some of the services provided are specialized-victim centered advocacy, therapy, crisis intervention, material & food assistance, transportation, Girls Circle, a parenting program, peer mentoring and an onsite CCSD approved school.

The Embracing Project is the only drop-in center of its kind in Las Vegas that serves sexually exploited youth. Through collaboration with other agencies The Embracing Project has the ability to connect youths & families to meaningful services, including support groups, individual, group & family therapy.

In her 2014, CSEC Fast Fact, a report on Clark County's experience with Commercially Sexually Exploited Youth, Dr. Alexis Kennedy highlighted The Embracing Project as a majority provider of advocacy services to the CSEC population of Clark County, serving 89% of the 202 youth determined to be Sexually Exploited Youth by the courts. The average age of exploitation is 14.
